INDICATIVE PROCUREMENT SPECIFICATION

For initial technical discussion. Not a lot-specific certificate of analysis, a stock offer or evidence of certification.

01 Material & intended use

Used cooking oil (UCO), recovered after food preparation, for assessment as a renewable fuel feedstock. Intended applications include UCOME biodiesel and eligible SAF production pathways, subject to producer acceptance. The material is not finished fuel.

02 Indicative quality targets

Targets supplied for commercial scoping; no tested batch is represented. Agree additional parameters, units, methods and tolerances with the receiving refinery. Independent testing and lot acceptance remain necessary.

03 Proposed corridor & handling

East African sourcing; FOB Mombasa, Kenya or CIF a named ARA port (Amsterdam, Rotterdam or Antwerp), subject to agreement. Indicative 20 ft flexitank net payload: 21-23 MT, depending on equipment, density, permitted loading and carrier acceptance.

Lifecycle GHG: the proposed > 83% saving is a fuel-pathway target subject to verified lifecycle calculation. It is not a measured property of UCO or a guarantee for a shipment or SAF pathway.

Before a transaction

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01 Confirm the lot and sampling plan

Identify the material, physical location and proposed quantity. Agree representative sampling, sample custody, retained samples and the independent inspection scope. SGS or Bureau Veritas may be proposed; appointment is confirmed by agreement.

02 Review the actual analytical results

Request the lot-specific certificate of analysis with sample identification, date, results, units and analytical methods. Resolve any mismatch between the agreed receiving specification and the result before accepting the material.

03 Verify sustainability evidence

Check the relevant operator certificates, legal names, validity and activity scope. Review origin records, applicable sustainability declarations or proof of sustainability, and relevant UDB records. This PDF does not establish Turco & Co certification, registration or third-party endorsement.

04 Align commercial documents

Agree quantities, quality determination, delivery responsibilities, inspection and shipping documents. An irrevocable transferable letter of credit at sight is a proposed structure, subject to bank acceptance and complying documents. Applicable FOSFA terms require express agreement.

05 Send the receiving requirement

Contact trading@turcoandco.com with the intended application, plant specification, indicative volume, destination and delivery window. Confirm technical, compliance and contractual requirements before a binding purchase.
